Note from the Director

The Washington and Lee Soccer Camp is designed to enhance the technical and tactical ability of each player in a fun and positive environment. Designed for female players aged 10 through high school seniors, the W&L Camp offers quality instruction by coaches with experience at all levels of the game. A low coach to player ratio ensures that all campers receive quality instruction time. On behalf of the staff, we look forward to seeing you for an exciting week of soccer.

TEAM TRAINING

A team of ten (10) or more may come to camp together and receive a discount for each player (\$20 per player). The team will train together in all aspects of their soccer development. All team applications and deposits must be sent in one envelope.

SIGNING UP

A \$200 non-refundable deposit required. Upon receipt of your deposit, a packet of material will be sent to each camper. Information in the packet will include: medical forms, an equipment check-list, dorm room supply list, maps of the area and further information on check-in procedures. Final payment and signed forms are required prior to check-in.

No Refunds after June 1st.

LOCATION

Historic Lexington, Virginia, is home to Washington and Lee University. Situated at the foot of the beautiful Blue Ridge Mountains, W&L is convenient to I-81 and I-64. The campus is about 45 miles north of Roanoke and 150 miles southwest of Washington, DC.

Day Campers/Commuters

Day campers should arrive at camp by 9 am each morning and depart at 8 pm. Lunch and dinner will be provided each day for day campers.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

Residential campers will check-in on Sunday, June 17 between 12 noon and 2 pm. Checkout will be Thursday, June 21 at 12 noon. Day Campers/Commuters will check-in at registration Sunday, June 17 at 2:30 pm.

INSURANCE AND MEDICAL

A certified athletic trainer will be on duty fulltime. A waiver and insurance form will be sent upon registration for camp. The completed form must be returned prior to or presented upon arrival at camp. Every effort is made to protect the health and safety of our campers. STAFF

Neil Cunningham, Camp Director, is the Head Coach of the Washington and Lee women's soccer program. In ten seasons Cunningham has posted a 156-37-23 record, captured the ODAC Conference title three times and advanced his squad to the NCAA Elite 8 in 2006.



A native of England, Cunningham earned a bachelors degree in physical education from West London Institute of Higher Education and a masters degree from Virginia Commonwealth University. He holds USSF, NSCAA and FA Coaching Licenses. Cunningham was also named ODAC Coach of the Year and NSCAA South Region Coach of the Year in 2002, 2006 and 2009.

LAST YEAR AT CAMP

Last year the camp was attended by members of the Salem Sabres, and Rockbridge County High School. Individual campers came from Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Minnesota, New Jersey, New York, North Carolina, Ohio, Pennsylvania, Texas, Tennessee, Virginia, and Washington. **Camp sold out a month early last year.**

The 2011 team had 17 players that attended camp in 2008, 2009 and 2010.

FACILITIES

Washington and Lee offers an excellent collegiate soccer facility nestled on a beautiful secluded campus in the Blue Ridge Mountains. Players will make use of grass and artificial surfaces. Housing is provided in W&L's dormitories. Meals are served through the university's cafeteria while a variety of recreational activities are planned for the week.
